Yilan Yeh is a Taiwanese new media artist, performer and curator resident in the Southern Moreton Bay Islands, Queensland, Australia. Her Work includes video art, digital projection for live performance, sound sculpture performance, exhibitions, animation and curatorial and artist in residence programs. She has created video installations for theatre productions and environmental performances in Europe, Australia and Taiwan. Yilan has been a full time lecturer and an assistant professor at universities in Taiwan and obtained her PhD in Media Arts from the University of New South Wales in 2008.

Yilan attained a Bachelor degree in journalism at the Chinese Culture University, Taiwan. After working as a graphic designer, she went on to study Computer Arts at the Academy of Art College, San Francisco where she received her Master of Fine Arts degree. Yilan's research focused on experimental animation and motion graphics integrating 2D/3D animation, live action, rotoscoping and matte painting skills with digital media in her film *The Orphans of the Earth—a Lost Forest*.

Yilan's PhD research expanded animation/video production to site-specific installation exploring Chinese Taoist aesthetics as digital practice. Her PhD project *Dancing Brush* video installation created a new form of modern cityscape where the principals of Taoism, ancient Chinese landscape painting and calligraphy meet Western new media aesthetics. In "Dancing Brush" Yilan transcribed physical reality into animation and subtracted in-between frames to bring the 'unknown' to life. Yilan explores the concept of traditional 'rotoscoping' technique as 're-animate' process in digital manipulation and brings up a new perspective in making animation.

In 2004 she began an extended collaboration with musician and visual artist Colin Offord specializing in video art projection and performance on his Moonbells and Waterbells. In 2010 we founded CURLEW REPUBLIC as both a performance and a production company. Projects include:

- CURLEW REPUBLIC video projection performances Walking on the Water at Tin Shed Theatre, Cootamundra Arts Centre, NSW. Compositions of Sound/Redlands Arts Council, Butter Factory Arts Centre, Cooroy, QLD, Théâtre Vidy-Lausanne, Switzerland and at Show Gallery Kaohsiung Taiwan, January 2011.
- Southsea Earthharp: environmental sound sculpture community music project, Macleay Island QLD. Regional Art Development Grant, Redland City Council & Queensland Government Arts program.
- Transience, site-specific immersive performance events which transform the architectural and natural environment into transitory worlds of moving images and sounds. Transience premiered at Gosford Regional Art Gallery Japanese Gardens, Australia in October 2007. In 2008 transience was invited by Tura New Music in Perth to stage events at the Sounds Outback Festival in the semi-arid desert environment of Wogarno Station followed by a tour of the North West region staging performances at the "Pearl Luggers", Broome, in Ivanhoe Gardens Kunnanurra and in the gardens of Darwin Cultural Centre. Lines In The Sand Festival, Point Lookout, North Stradbroke Island 2011.
- A film-concert "Tyranny of Distance" commissioned by the Théâtre de Maillon at Strasbourg. With the support of Screen-sound Australia the work combines Offord and Yilan's videography with images from the 1923 silent film masterpiece "For the Term of His Natural Life".
